

### Headset overview





Be safe

Please read the safety guide for important safety, charging, battery and regulatory information before using your new headset.

### Pair


#### Get paired

The first time you power on your headset, the pairing process begins.

- 1 Press and hold the Call 🖯 button until the LEDs flash red and blue.
- 2 Activate **Bluetooth**® on your phone and set it to search for new devices.
  - iPhone Settings > Bluetooth > On\*
  - Android Settings > Bluetooth: On > Scan for devices\*

**NOTE** \*Menus may vary by device.

3 Select "PLT\_ML15." If necessary, enter four zeros (0000) for the passcode or accept the connection. Once successfully paired, the LEDs stop flashing.



#### Pair Another Phone

After pairing your headset to your phone, you may want to pair another phone.

- 1 Power on your headset.
- 2 Press and hold the Call ☐ button until the indicator light → flashes red and blue.
- 3 Activate Bluetooth on your phone and set it to search for new devices.
- 4 Select "PLT\_ML15."

If necessary, enter four zeros (0000) for the passcode or accept the connection.

Once successfully paired, the headset indicator lights stop flashing.


#### Reconnect

Your Bluetooth headset has up to 10 meters effective range. If you lose connection, your headset will try to reconnect. If your headset doesn't reconnect, tap the Call  $\bigcirc$  button or manually connect through the phone's Bluetooth device menu.

# Charge and fit

#### Charge


Your new headset has enough power to pair and make a few calls. It takes 2 hours to fully charge the headset; the indicator light turns solid blue once charging is complete.



#### Adjust the fit

The universal-fit eartip has a thin loop that bends to gently tuck into the contours of either ear.

To adjust the fit, you can rotate the eartip on the headset or add the optional clip-on earloop.



### The basics

Power

To power on or off, press the Call 🖯 button until the indicator 🔆 light flashes blue once (on) or red once (off).

Make/Take/End Calls

#### Answer or end a call

Tap the Call ☐ button.

#### Redial

To dial your last number you dialed, double-tap the Call 🖯 button.

#### Voice dial

If your phone supports voice-activated dialing, press and hold the Call  $\odot$  button for 2 seconds and wait for the phone prompt and then tell the phone to dial the number of a stored contact.

Volume

Adjust the volume on your phone to control your headset volume.

#### Decipher the lights

Your headset has an indicator light  $\sqrt[2]{c}$  that flashes in response to a change in status or after a button press.

Some examples of what you will see are:

- Solid red until charging complete and then solid blue
- · Flashing red and blue during pairing
- Double red flash when battery low
- Double blue flash at incoming call
